Towards a better tomorrow

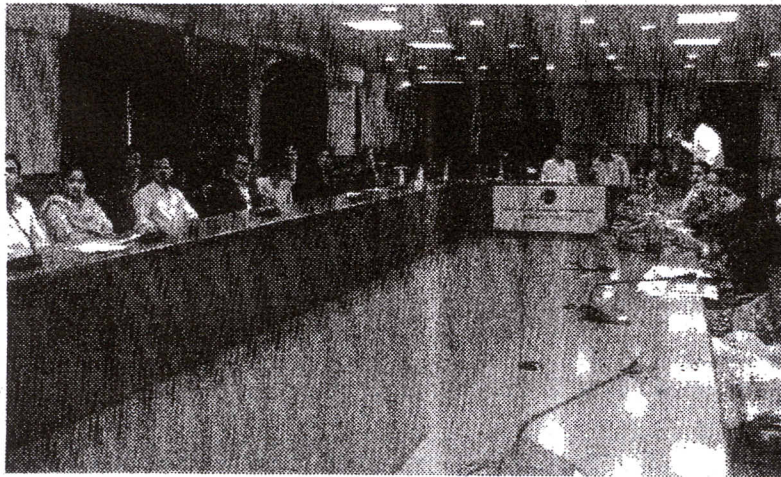

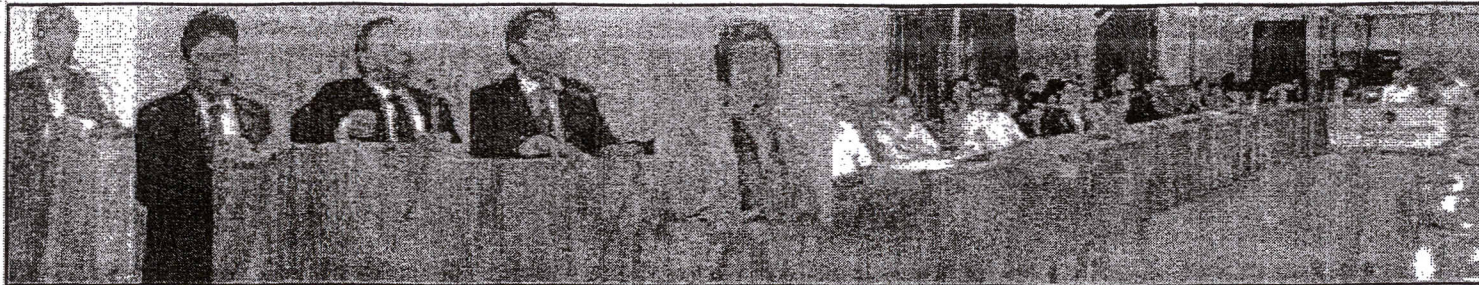
